Essential Materials for Your Cozy Creation

- **Yarn:** Worsted weight yarn in main color (MC) and contrasting color (CC)
- **Knitting Needles:** US size 8 (5mm)
- **Yarn Needle:** For weaving in ends
- **Stitch Marker:** Optional, for marking beginning of rounds

Step-by-Step Instructions: A Journey of Comfort

Foundation Row: Cast on 108 stitches with MC.

Row 1-4: Knit all stitches.

Row 5: Knit 2, *P2, K2; repeat from * to last 2 stitches, K2.

Row 6: Knit all stitches.

Repeat rows 5-6 until piece measures 6 inches from foundation row.

Divide for Hood: Slip first 20 stitches onto a holder, place stitch marker on next stitch (beginning of round), CO 30 stitches, place stitch marker on next stitch, slip remaining 54 stitches onto a holder.

The holders will create the sides of the sleeping bag, while the stitches on the needles will form the hood.

Hood: Work in the round, joining with a sl st into the first stitch, place stitch marker. Knit 80 stitches evenly. Join with a sl st into the next stitch.

Row 2-6: Knit all stitches.

Row 7: *K1, P2; repeat from * around.

Row 8: Knit all stitches.

Row 9: *K2, P2; repeat from * around.

Row 10: Knit all stitches.

Row 11: *K3, P2; repeat from * around.

Row 12: Knit all stitches.

Row 13: *K4, P2; repeat from * around.

Row 14: Knit all stitches.

Row 15: *K5, P2; repeat from * around.

Row 16: Knit all stitches.

Row 17: *K6, P2; repeat from * around.

Row 18: Knit all stitches.

Row 19: *K7, P2; repeat from * around.

Row 20: Knit all stitches.

Row 21: *K8, P2; repeat from * around.

Row 22: Knit all stitches.

Row 23: *K9, P2; repeat from * around.

Row 24: Knit all stitches.

Row 25: *K10, P2; repeat from * around.

Row 26: Knit all stitches.

Row 27: BO all stitches.

Fold the hood in half, with the wrong sides together, and sew the sides together.

To make the ears, simply fold the top corners of the hood down and sew them together.

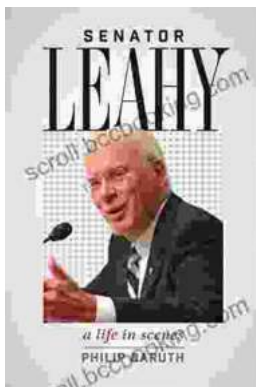
